

Advisory for DD Kisan dated 26.04.19

(Agromet Advisories mentioned in the inputs are prepared by different Agromet Field Units in the country)

Significant Weather Features

- The well marked low pressure area over east Equatorial Indian Ocean & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal has concentrated into a depression over the same region and lay centered at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 26th April 2019 near Lat. 2.7°N and Long. 89.7°E, about 1140 km east southeast of Trincomalee (Sri Lanka), 1490 km southeast of Chennai and 1760 km southsoutheast of Machilipatnam. It is very likely to intensify further into a deep depression during next 24 hours and into a Cyclonic Storm during subsequent 12 hours. It is very likely to move northwestwards off Srilanka coast during next 96 hours and reach near north Tamilnadu & south Andhra Pradesh coasts on 30th April 2019 evening.

Realised Weather

(From 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today):

- **Rain/Thundershowers observed (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today):** at most places over Jammu & Kashmir; at a few places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and at isolated places over West Rajasthan, West Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya, Kerala, Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- **Thunderstorms** observed at a few places over Jammu & Kashmir and at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Punjab, Sub-Himalayan west Bengal & Sikkim Assam & Meghalaya, Bihar, Madhya Maharashtra, Kerala and Lakshadweep from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today.
- Yesterday, heat wave conditions were observed at isolated pockets over West Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha.
- **Maximum temperature departures as on 25-04-2019:** Maximum temperatures were markedly above normal (5.1°C or more) at a few places over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya; appreciably above normal (3.1°C to 5.0°C) at most places over Vidarbha and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura; at many places over Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, West Madhya Pradesh, Marathwada and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; at a few places over Himachal Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh and Madhya Maharashtra; at isolated places over Rajasthan;
Yesterday, the highest maximum temperature of 46.5°C was recorded at **Khargone** (West Madhya Pradesh).

Weather Forecast for next 5 days upto 0830 hours IST 18th April 2019

- Meteorological sub-division wise detailed 5 days precipitation forecast is given in Table-1.
- Day maximum temperatures are very likely to rise by 2-4°C over east India during next 4 days. No significant change likely over the rest of the country during this period.

Weather Warning

- **26 April (Day 1):** Squally wind, speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph and rough Seas very likely over east Equatorial Indian Ocean & adjoining central parts of south Bay of Bengal. Squally weather very likely over south Andaman Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

- **27 April (Day 2): Gale wind, speed reaching 65-75 kmph gusting to 85 kmph and rough to very rough Seas** very likely over Southwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining east Equatorial Indian Ocean. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning, squall (wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph) at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya and **(wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph)** at isolated places very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim.

Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph) and lightning at isolated places very likely over north Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

Strong wind speed reaching 30-40 Kmph gusting to 50 Kmph very likely along & off Tamilnadu & Puducherry coasts, Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar and over Kerala. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning and squall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph) at isolated places likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and Assam & Meghalaya.

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning and gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) at isolated places very likely over Kerala **and with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places likely over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

Heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh.

- **30 April (Day 5): Gale wind, speed reaching 90-100 kmph gusting to 115 kmph and high to very high Seas** likely over Southwest Bay of Bengal along & off north Tamilnadu & Puducherry and south Andhra Pradesh coasts. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning, hail and gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) at isolated places likely over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning and gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) likely over Tamilnadu, Kerala, South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh; **gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places likely over south Chhattisgarh & Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and **with Dust storm and gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph)** over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and north Rajasthan.

Heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over north coastal Tamilnadu & Puducherry, south Coastal Andhra Pradesh, South Interior Karnataka, Assam & Meghalaya and Kerala.

Advisory

- In the above regions, provide mechanical support to young fruit plants, banana and staking in vegetables to prevent the crops from lodging due to strong winds. Undertake propping in sugarcane. Postpone application of plant protection measures and fertilizers to the standing crops during Strong / Squally / Gale wind /Gusty winds. Use hail net for orchard crops to protect from mechanical damage.

Advisory

- In above regions, apply light and frequent irrigation to the standing crops to cope up with the excess evaporative demand due to high temperature; mulching with straw to conserve soil moisture. Provide shade for protection of young fruit plants from scorching sun.

Advisory

- In above regions, postpone irrigation, intercultural operation and application of plant protection measures and fertilizers to the standing crops. Keep harvested produce at safer places.

State-wise Advisories

Assam, Arunachal Pradesh and Mizoram

- In Lower Bramhaputra Valley Zone of Assam, continue transplanting of *ahu* rice seedlings. Complete planting of ginger by end of this month.
- In Barak Valley zone of Assam, in *boro* rice there is chance of Gandhi bug attack, to control apply 5% Malathoin dust @ 20 kg per ha of land.
- In North Bank Plain Zone of Assam, undertake land preparation/ sowing of *bau* rice, planting of sugarcane and complete planting of ginger.
- In Arunachal Pradesh, undertake nursery preparation/ transplanting of rice, continue sowing of leguminous crops like cowpea, French bean, soybean etc. around Jhum field
- In Upper Bramhaputra Valley Zone of Assam, continue sowing of maize, undertake planting of banana suckers in main field.
- In Central Bramhaputra Valley Zone of Assam, continue sowing of Summer green gram & black gram, undertake land preparation/sowing of jute and summer vegetables.

Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh

- In Sub Tropical Zone of Jammu & Kashmir, complete harvesting of early sown wheat and late sown pea.
- In Intermediate Zone of Jammu & Kashmir, continue sowing of okra and French bean.
- In Valley Temperate Zone of Jammu & Kashmir, undertake transplanting of vegetable seedlings in open fields. Undertake sowing of beans and direct sowing of cucurbits.
- In High Hill Temperate Dry Zone of Himachal Pradesh, undertake sowing of pea

Uttarakhand

- In Bhabar and Tarai Zone, continue harvesting of wheat and pulses. Continue sowing of French beans. To control the leaf blight disease in onion, spray Propiconazole @ 500ml/ha with any sarvangi insecticide and sticker.

- In Sub-Humid Sub-Tropic Zone carry out threshing of harvested wheat crop.

Punjab Haryana and New Delhi

- In Punjab, complete harvesting/threshing of wheat and mustard crop. Undertake sowing of cotton including Bt cotton or desi Cotton.
- In Delhi, Undertake field preparation for sowing of pigeon pea and cotton.

Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh

- In East Madhya Pradesh, continue harvesting of matured wheat. In Kymore Plateau and Satpura Hill Zone, continue sowing of moong and summer vegetables and sowing of watermelon, melon, cucumber etc.
- In West Madhya Pradesh, undertake sowing of summer moong in fallow fields under assured irrigation.
- In Bastar Plateau Zone of Chhattisgarh, complete harvesting of wheat. Undertake sowing of sponge gourd, cucumber, ridge gourd watermelon, muskmelon and bitter gourd.

Rajasthan

- In Irrigated Northwestern Plain Zone, undertake sowing of desi cotton American cotton and Bt Cotton.
- In Sub Humid Southern Plain and Aravali Hill Zone, undertake harvesting, threshing and storing of wheat crop may be done as early as possible.
- In Semi Arid Eastern Plain Zone, fruit borer may attack okra crop, pickup the affected fruits and buried them in soil. Spray Melathion 50 EC @ 1.0 ml per litre water.

Maharashtra

- In Konkan region continue harvesting of early sown varieties of rice. Continue harvesting of early sown groundnut.
- In Madhya Maharashtra, in Maize, to control army worm/ Spodoptera frujiperda, spray Chlorantraniliprole (18.5 % S.C.) @ 150 ml per ha in 500 liters of water.
- In Marathwada, provide shade for protection of young fruit plants of sapota from scorching sun.

Odisha

- Undertake sowing of baby corn and planting of ginger and yam, undertake land preparation for planting of turmeric in the months of May and June. undertake harvesting of green gram and black gram .

Bihar and Jharkhand

- In North West Alluvial Plain Zone of Bihar, undertake harvesting of wheat.
- In Jharkhand undertake sowing of improved varieties of summer cowpea, ginger, turmeric and elephant foot yam.

West Bengal

- In Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, undertake transplanting of ginger and turmeric to main field. In maize, to control cob worm spray Neem oil 1% @ 3ml/litre of water with sticker @ 0.5ml/litre at evening hours.
- In Gangetic West Bengal, in rice to control Brown plant hopper, Spray Buprofezin 25% SC @ 106 ml/bigha .
- In New Alluvial Zone, undertake harvesting of boro rice.

Andhra Pradesh Kerala and Telangana Karnataka

- In High Altitude Tribal Zone of North Coastal Andhra Pradesh continue harvesting of sunflower
- In Rayalaseema, the present weather conditions are favourable for attack of white fly and jassids in greengram, to control spray Imidachloprid 0.3 ml./litre or Diphenthiuron 1 glitre.
- In Northern Telangana, undertake harvesting of rice and sesame. In groundnut to control Late tikka leaf spot, spray Chlorothalonil @ 2 g/litre or Tebuconazole @ 1 ml per liter of water.
